Art for Hope is the annual fundraising auction for Josh's Hope Foundation, with a goal of raising \$25,000 to provide resources and hope to young adults living with mental illness, and their families. This year's auction will be on November 11 at the Durham Jewish Community Center and we are honored to have NC Sen. Mike Woodard and Rep. Graig Meyer as our co-auctioneers.

Art for Hope offers guests the opportunity to bid on art in a variety of mediums during both a silent and live auction. All works must be donated to Josh's Hope. Though not all items can be featured in the live auction, all selected items will be eligible for a People's Choice Award in the areas of:

- 1) fabric or functional (including wearable art, furniture or woodworking)
- 2) mixed media (including photography)
- 3) ceramic, pottery, glass, including sculptures
- 4) paintings (oils, acrylics, watercolors)
- 5) jewelry (metalsmith or hand-beaded designs)

Please make sure your work is in one of these categories. All voting for the award will be done by community members, both online in advance and live during the event.

Awards will be given at the event. All artists whose items are selected for the auctions will receive two tickets to the event.
